Our scope of work extended beyond millwork to include the installation of sliding glass walls, starfire mirrors, fabric-clad walls, and a luxurious 14-foot dining table finished with high-gloss lacquer.

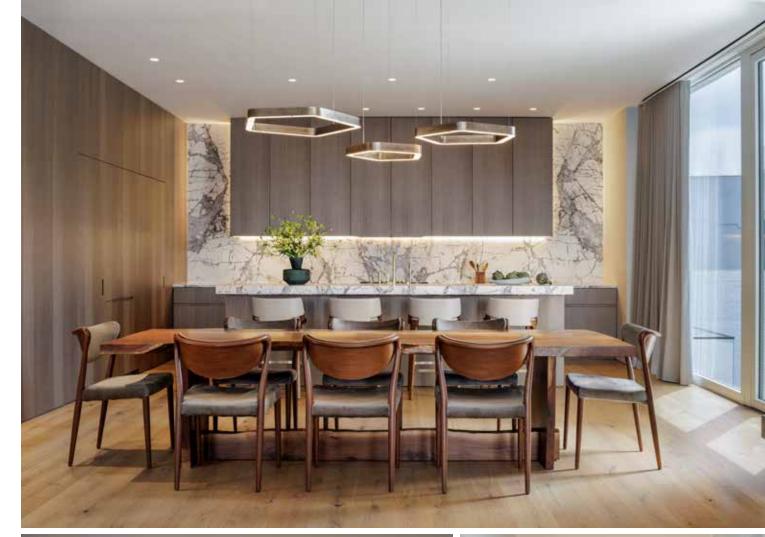

The penthouse's standout feature is an opulent floor-to-ceiling marble fireplace adorned with custom brass fluting. This same marble extends to the kitchen countertops and backsplash, complemented by custom wood paneling throughout. The bathrooms are thoughtfully designed with a spa-like ambiance, boasting unique stone and wood vanities that imbue each one with its distinctive character. The rooftop provides an idyllic escape from the rigors of daily life, featuring a custom-flamed granite fireplace, a bespoke outdoor kitchen, and a firepit area with custom seating.

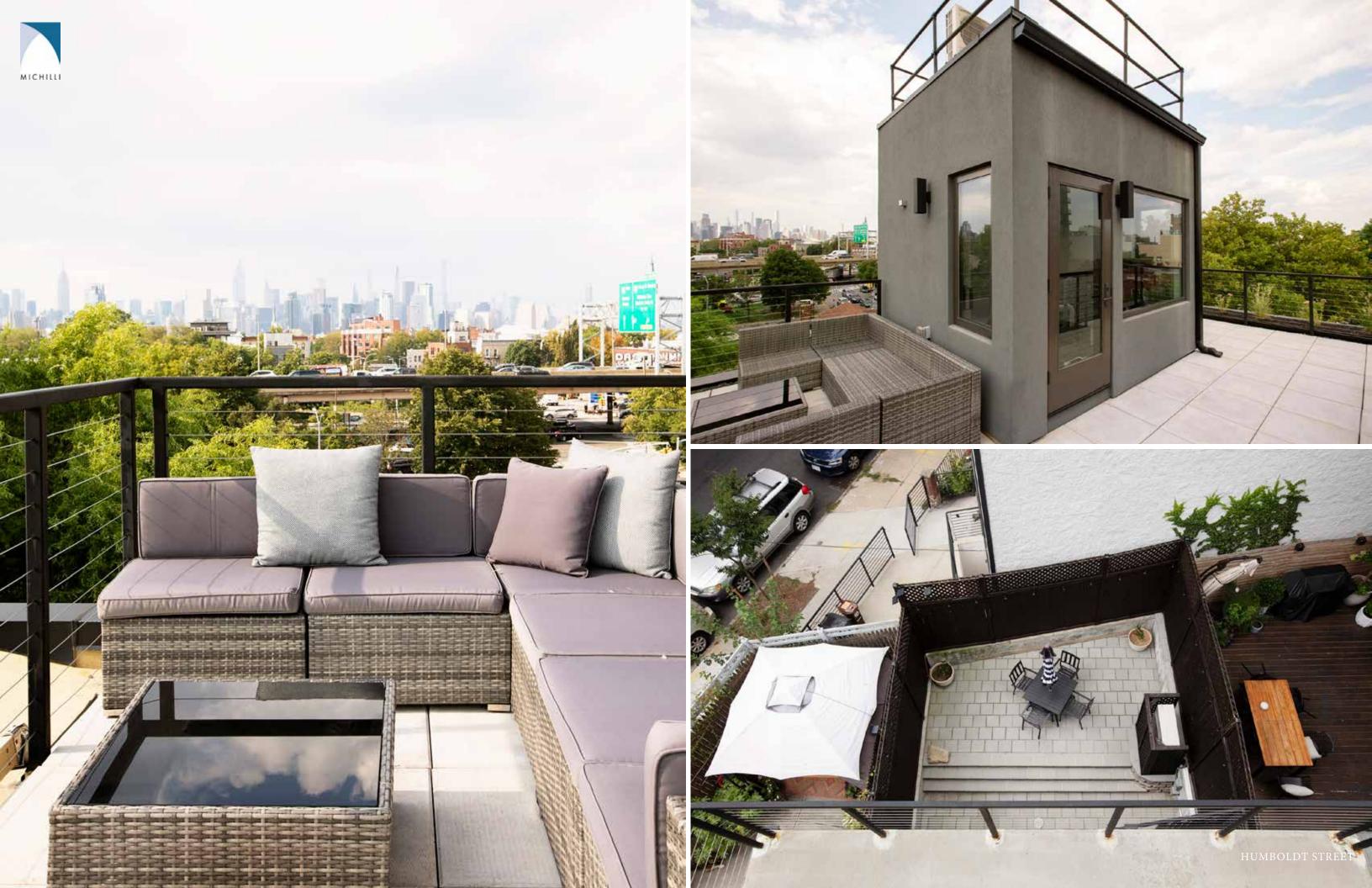

Crowning the structure is a seamless monolithic concrete cantilevered roof, providing a sturdy foundation for the rooftop garden that offers breathtaking views of the Manhattan skyline. The front facade boasts a distinctive metal cladding, artfully divided to frame windows, echoing the interior's steel grid layout.

Our scope of work encompassed the demolition of the existing structure, followed by the ground-up development of the new 2800 square foot structure, and a comprehensive interior fit out.

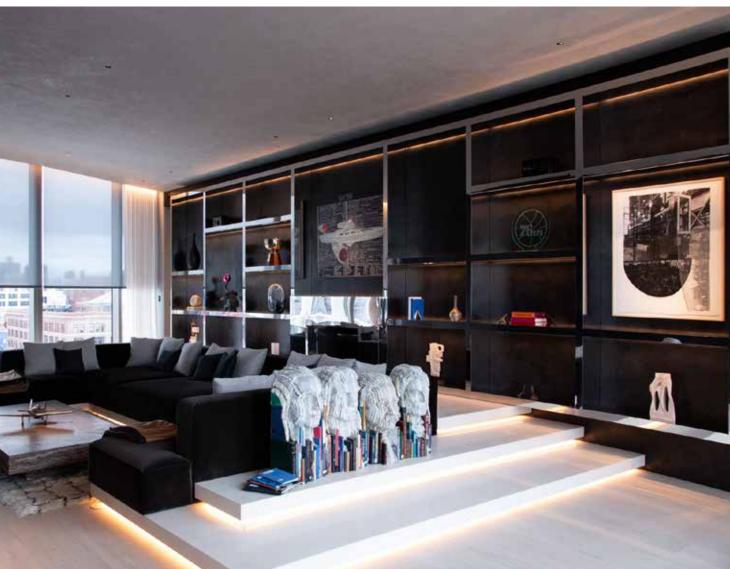

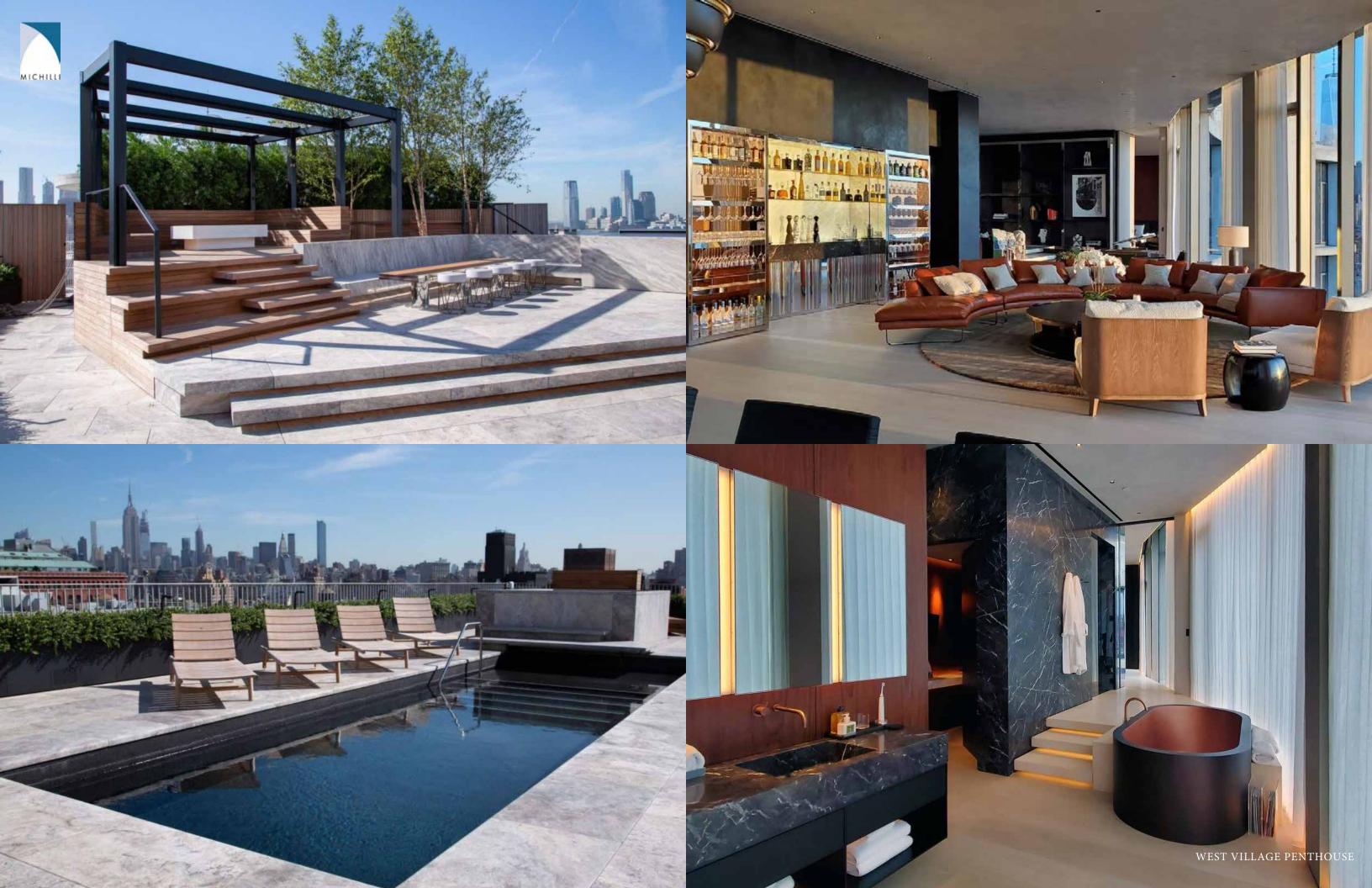

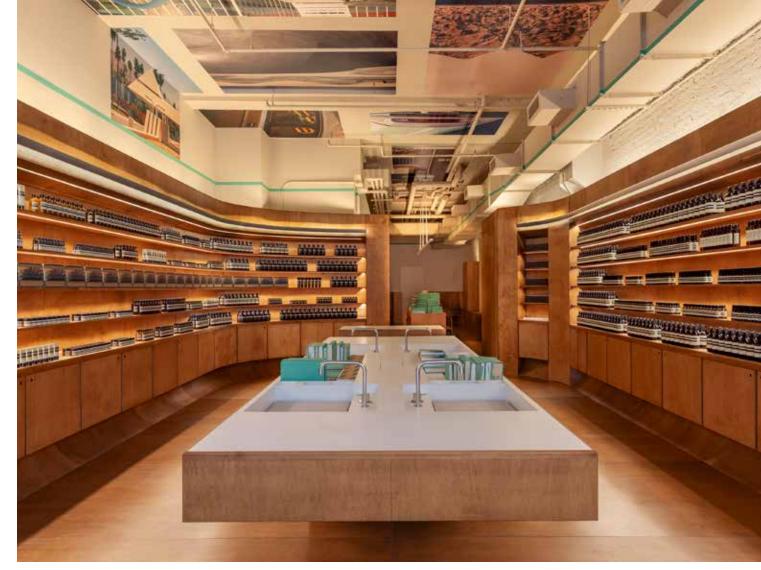

# BALENCIAGA

Balenciaga's flagship on Madison Avenue, spanning 4,000 square feet and located at the southwest corner of 59th Street in Manhattan, embodies creative director Demna Gvasalia's urban retail concept. The design embraces an industrial aesthetic with accents of metal, concrete, and various shades of gray. This public domain concept seamlessly blends elements from metropolitan exterior design with original artwork. The space features wraparound screens showcasing videos depicting different types of skies. Hero products from the runway take center stage on hyper-realistic mannequins, creating a striking visual impact. The men's and women's shoe areas line one wall, offering a diverse range of footwear. The Balenciaga logo is elegantly embossed across the gray carpeting.

Throughout the flagship, seating is adorned with upholstery inspired by patterns found in public transportation, while benches mirror those seen in subway stations or parks. Adding an artistic touch, a piece by Tobias Spichtig is prominently displayed. Spichtig crafted sculptures by immersing archival Balenciaga garments in resin, shaping them into expressive positions.

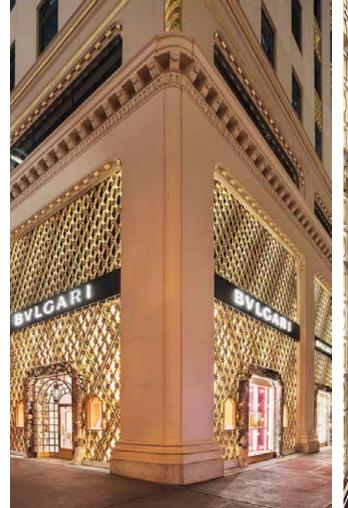

Bylgari's flagship construction involved reinforcing ground floor beams, adapting existing stone portals for new storefronts, and creating floor openings for duct risers. The facade featured a distinctive mesh pattern of diamond-shaped insulated units framed in brass, complemented by a "Rain Screen" with brass rosettes and computer-controlled LEDs. This intricate system, prefabricated in Italy and shipped in crates, required extensive troubleshooting and testing. Notable features include a two-story facade with handmade rosettes and LED lighting, as well as overseeing the installation of a custom marble staircase and brass grilles.

In 2019, Carolina Herrera unveiled their redesigned flagship on Madison Avenue in New York. The three-level store, spanning 6,900 square feet, underwent a transformation led by a prestigious design team including Spacesmith, designer Chiara de Rege, and Studio Mellone. Inspired by the Herrera archives, the revamped space incorporates vibrant hues of pink, fuchsia, and turquoise. The ground floor now showcases women's apparel, while a elegantly curved staircase leads to the second floor, dedicated to additional fragrances and fashion. The third floor features a bridal salon with blush-toned furnishings. Six fitting rooms are a visual delight, characterized by vivid macaron-like hues, bespoke bullion fringe, velvet chaises, travertine-and-brass demilune tables, velvet ribbon trimming, and state-of-the-art lighting integrated into mirrors. The custom chandelier, composed of pink Venini art glass flowers, adds a unique touch. Arched niches serve a dual purpose as clothing and fragrance displays, making the entire space a truly captivating sight.

Céline's Florida flagship is located in the Design District of Miami and encompassed a total of 5,217 square feet spanning two floors. Project highlights include extensive structural steel work, which was conducted to accommodate new storefront systems, staircases, and pyramid framing. Façade work included framing and glass systems on both the first and second floors. Our scope of work also meant the installation of a two level feature staircase made of concrete with a custom brass railing. Structural and architectural concrete was another major facet of the project and is used for aesthetic purposes throughout the store. This included columns, footings, benches, panels, and miscellaneous concrete infills. Certain aspects of which we had to ensure was properly supported to meet safety requirements –such a triangular archway on the second floor which serves as a focal point and a supporting column which was converted into an obelisk structure. We furnished and installed oak wood flooring where specified and provided high density shelving, appliances, fire protection systems, and data systems. HVAC and electrical systems were upgraded with new equipment and controls.

Chopard recently unveiled their stunning new flagship at 730 Fifth Avenue in the historic Crown Building. Drawing inspiration from New York's Art Deco period, the boutique was transformed into a two-level penthouse spanning 2,450 square feet with soaring 16-foot-high ceilings on the first floor. Suspended from the ceiling in the main salon are 400 custom-made Murano glass magnolia leaves designed by master glassmaker Venini. The chandeliers are a nod to Central Park's magnolia trees, and the leaf motif extends to four openings on the walls, representing the four seasons. Equally stunning are the rich mahogany and brass vitrines, Fior di Bosco Italian marble flooring, amethyst tables, custom brass doors, velvet-clad furnishings, and floor-to-ceiling LED screens found throughout the boutique. The lower level houses a VIP area, the Gentlemen's Club, and the Haute Joaillerie salon.

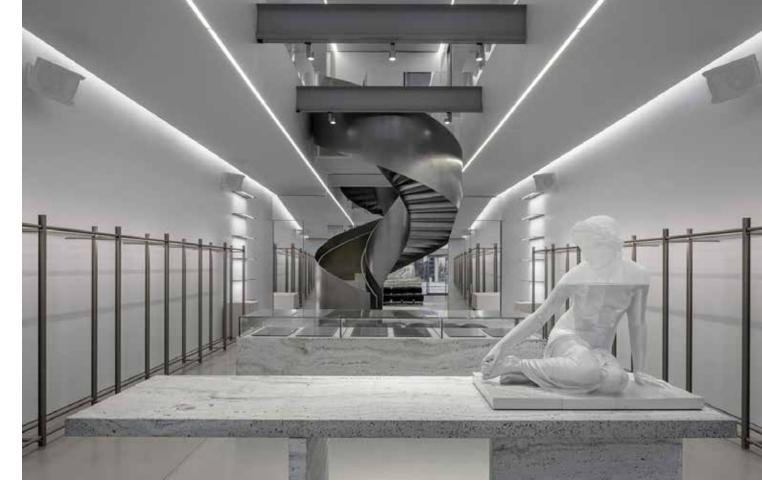

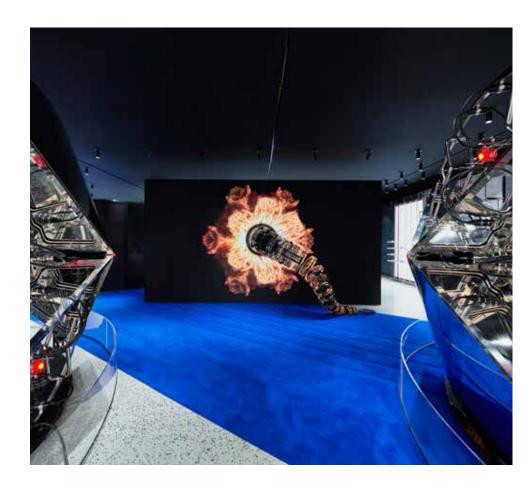

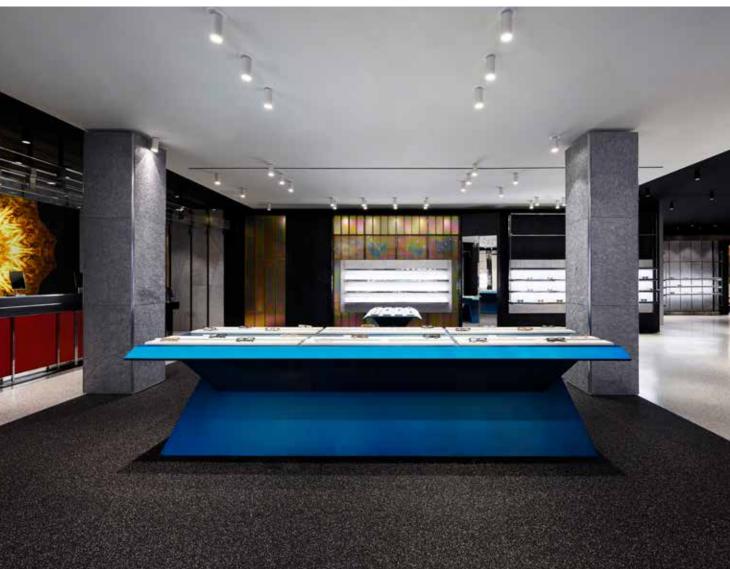

With grid-patterned metal mesh ceilings, a curved staircase constructed of shiny mirrored tiles, and painted cement flooring, the interior design expertly marries the sophisticated craftsmanship of Florence with the urban style of New York. A '70s aesthetic is brought to life through a pastel color palette, with shades of green, blue, and pink appearing throughout the store. Mid-century furniture, including restored second-hand pieces, and mirrored surfaces continue to pay homage to the decade.

The ground floor houses the brand's full collection and an expected pop of color in the red-lit, carpeted fitting rooms. The lower level, which includes a VIP room, office, and back-of-house, is reserved for celebs, style insiders, and staff. Our scope of work included a full demolition and interior buildout, new HVAC and electrical systems, and all new interior finishes for both the ground floor and lower level.

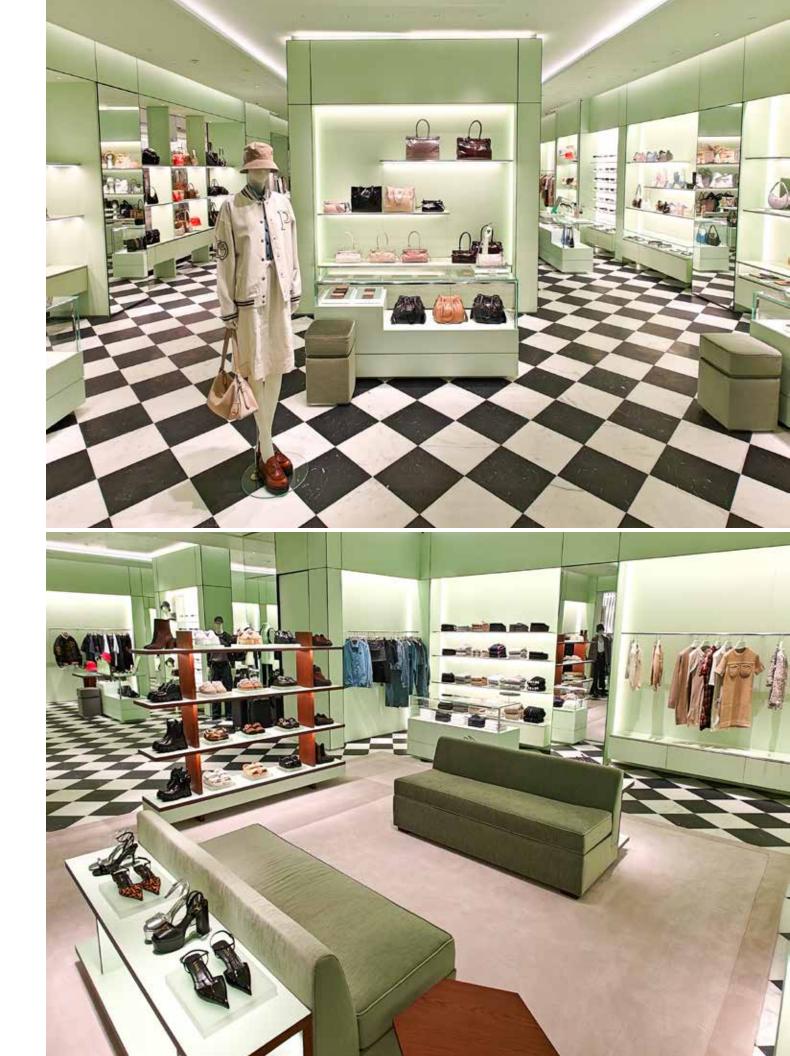

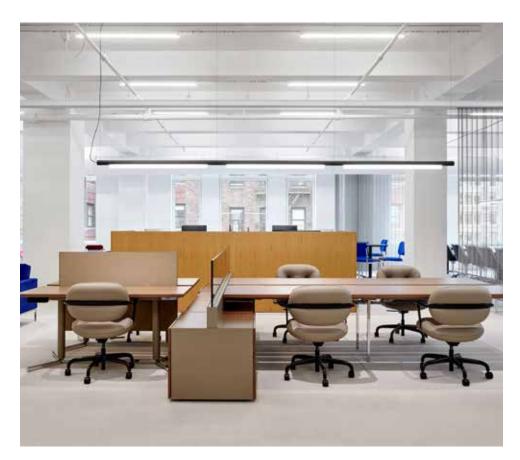

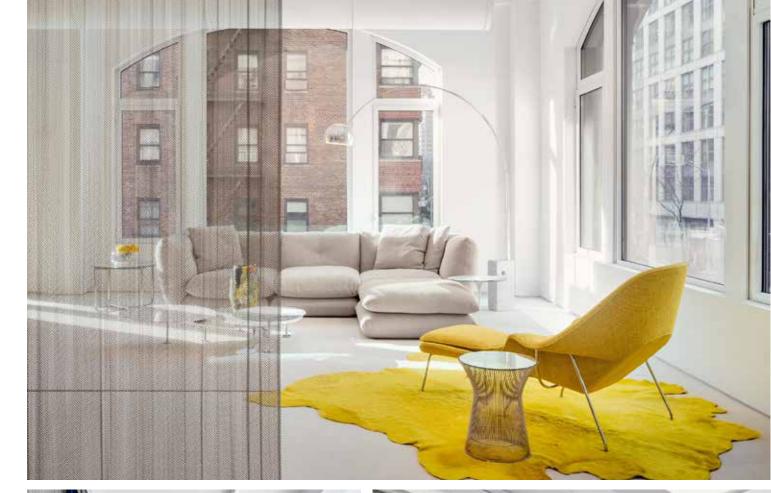

One of the biggest Modern Animal outposts to date, the clinic has 10 full exam rooms and spans almost 5,000 square feet. These rooms include specialized ones for services such as X-rays, surgery, and dental work. Our scope of work includes a full gut demo of the former bank, keeping only the previous bank vault intact, which has been repurposed as the Dental Room. A vaulted, painted wood ceiling in the lobby entryway creates a luxurious and airy feeling while providing a welcoming atmosphere for both pets and their owners. The clinic also houses a large business office for the doctors and a standalone pharmacy. The back-of-house section includes 30 self-ventilated glass-door pet enclosures in addition to a breakroom with a full kitchen and gorgeous hardwood finishes. Six full-size animal enclosures with a pet wash area are located adjacent to the X-Ray room, prioritizing the comfort and wellbeing of the animals while they are there. The installation of advanced systems such as the in-wall and ceiling medical gas system, high-tech fire alarm, and sprinkler system contribute to the safety and efficiency of medical procedures.

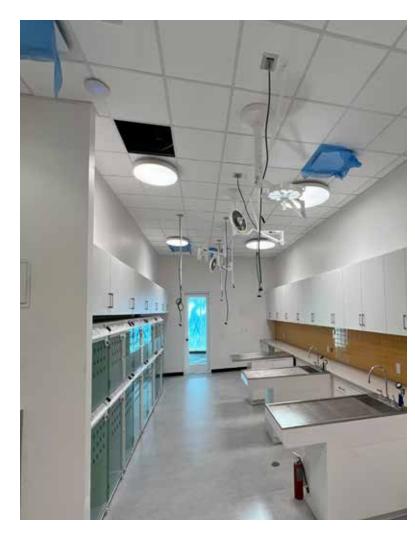

The New York Dermatology Group Integral Health and Wellness flagship facility is located within Manhattan's historic Ladies' Mile District. Comprising over 7,000 square feet of specialist wellness, therapy, and treatment facilities, the project is located on the second floor of a 1905 landmark building originally designed by John Duncan. The flagship features treatment rooms in an innovative pod-type structure that is centered in the 7,000 SF space, leaving the walls of double-scaled windows unobstructed. BHA designed the unique cladding system, built in Italy, in collaboration with Paolo Cassina Custom Interiors. This millwork pod, made of fiberglass batten panels, was especially designed for this area, with transparent glass strips in between each panel that have been outfitted with LED video displays. Other points of interest include fumed European Oak Viabizzuno built-ins, a baffled ceiling structure, and specialized lighting systems. The flooring in the reception area makes use of reclaimed stained oak flooring imported from Germany, while solid ground quartz is used in the treatment rooms.
